Building a Safe Home for Monjel Fokir

PROJECT SUMMARY

A fundraising project to build a simple, safe house on his own land for Monjel Fokir, a physically injured sole breadwinner supporting his family in Rajbari, Bangladesh.

PROGRESS UPDATE

Construction of Monjel Fokir's home is now fully complete. The house has been handed over and Monjel Fokir and his family have moved in and are living there. We thank every donor and supporter who made this possible. Your generosity has given an entire family security, dignity, and a place to call home

IMPACT

A safe house gives Monjel Fokir's family security, dignity, and protection from unsafe living conditions and harsh weather. It brings stability and peace of mind, allowing the family to live with greater hope and focus on building a better future.

PROJECT SUMMARY

Ongoing monthly financial support for vulnerable families and children around the world affected by old age, disability, illness, and loss of income, ensuring dignity, stability, and continued education.

PROGRESS UPDATE

Since commencing in January 2026, the program has provided ongoing monthly support to 4 vulnerable families, including funding the primary education of two children, supporting one young woman's higher study through to a nursing graduation. One-off livelihood assistance has also been extended to more than 36 families and 6 orphans, helping a father arrange his daughter's marriage ceremony with dignity, and providing a bicycle to a school-going student to ease his daily journey to school. As community awareness grows, so does the circle of those we are able to reach

IMPACT

The project has helped beneficiaries meet essential living needs and reduce immediate financial hardship. It has supported greater stability, dignity, and in many cases created opportunities for families to improve their livelihood and care for their children more securely.

PROJECT SUMMARY

Urgent fundraising to provide financial relief for Sahanaz Parveen's family facing extreme hardship due to illness, debt, and risk of eviction in Narayanganj, Bangladesh.

PROGRESS UPDATE

The funds have been handed over to Sahanaz Parveen's family, bringing immediate relief to a household that had been facing the very real threat of eviction and overwhelming financial hardship. We are deeply grateful to every member of our community who contributed to make this possible.

IMPACT

This has provided immediate financial breathing room for the family, helping address urgent needs and reducing the risk of eviction.

PROJECT SUMMARY

Abdul Kalam Azad is an electric goods delivery worker and sole provider for his family of four. Despite chronic asthma, he rode a manual bicycle across Dhaka daily. This project raised funds to help him purchase a battery-powered easy bike.

PROGRESS UPDATE

A new battery-driven EV ride has been purchased and handed over to Azad. The project has been successfully closed, with the full target met through community generosity.

IMPACT

The easy bike has reduced the physical strain on Azad, allowing him to work more comfortably despite his asthma. It has improved his income stability, helping him better support his family and his children's university education.





PROJECT 05 MICRO ENTERPRISE SUPPORT

Empower a Father to Grow His Small Business

PROJECT SUMMARY

Mojibur Dhali is a small electrical goods trader and sole provider for his family of four. Due to limited working capital, he could only purchase small quantities of goods. This project aimed to strengthen his business capital to increase stock and improve profit margins.

PROGRESS UPDATE

Fundraising met the target with additional contributions channelled through our local execution partner, Lighthouse Project Services in Bangladesh. Funds have been disbursed and the business has received the full capital injection.

IMPACT

The additional capital has created more stability in Mojibur's daily income and reduced financial pressure on his family. It has also strengthened his confidence to grow the business gradually and better support his household's ongoing needs.

Restore Hope Through a Rickshaw

PROJECT SUMMARY

Mohammad Hanef Ali Sheikh, a father supporting six family members, was forced to sell his only rickshaw during financial hardship. This project aims to purchase a new rickshaw so he can return to work, restore stable income, and support his family with dignity.

PROGRESS UPDATE

The full target has been successfully raised. A brand new battery-driven rickshaw has been manufactured and handed over to Mohammad Hanef Ali Sheikh, allowing him to return to work immediately and once again provide for his family with dignity and independence. We thank every donor who played a part in restoring this father's livelihood.

IMPACT

The battery-driven rickshaw has transformed Mohammad Hanef Ali Sheikh's situation, giving him a reliable and sustainable source of daily income to support his six family members. The battery-powered rickshaw also means less physical strain, allowing him to work more comfortably and productively. What began as a community appeal has ended as a story of hope restored.

PROJECT SUMMARY

This project supported three vulnerable small traders in Dhaka struggling to support their families due to very limited working capital. A modest capital boost helped them grow their businesses, improve daily income, and bring greater stability to their households.

PROGRESS UPDATE

The full funding has been successfully raised. Our local service provider purchased the required materials and handed them over to all three beneficiaries. The project is now complete and closed.

IMPACT

The support has strengthened the beneficiaries' ability to run their small businesses and generate more stable daily income. It has eased financial pressure, helped meet essential needs with dignity, and given them confidence toward more sustainable livelihoods.

PROJECT SUMMARY

Syed Saad Abdullah earned admission to a respected engineering university, securing an outstanding 35th position in the merit list. His family, burdened by debts exceeding BDT 3.5 crore following business fraud, a sick sibling, and household instability, cannot support his education. This project aims to secure a comprehensive fund covering tuition, accommodation, living expenses, and materials throughout his undergraduate years.

PROGRESS UPDATE

To date, AUD 3,345 has been raised toward the AUD 6,500 target — just over 51% of the way there. The appeal remains active and we urge our community to continue supporting Saad so he can pursue his studies without the constant fear of dropping out. Every contribution, however small, brings him closer to a future he has worked so hard to reach.

IMPACT

Securing Saad's education will give him and his entire family a real path out of hardship. As an engineering graduate he will be able to support his family, repay debts, and one day give back to his community. Every contribution is an investment in the power of education to transform lives.
